



Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment (WEEE) Recycling

Why should you recycle?

The amount of electrical waste being thrown away is increasing by approximately 5% each year, making it the fastest growing type of waste in the UK.

As a result of incorrect disposal, over 65% of electrical waste ends up in landfill sites, where hazardous substances may potentially leak out. This can cause soil and water contamination, which is harmful to both humans and wildlife.

Many electrical items that have reached the end of their useful lifespan can either be repaired for reuse or recycled, saving natural resources and the environment.

How can Totally Wicked help?

We have partnered with the sustainability solutions provider, WasteCare, which is one of only a handful of Approved Authorised Treatment Facilities (AATF) that can recycle vape products effectively.

Together, we have launched an industry-leading national vape recycling initiative that aims to prevent used vapes from ending up in landfills or littering our streets by recycling their components and returning them to the manufacturing supply chain.

Our programme provides vapers with an environmentally friendly and convenient way to recycle electrical equipment, addressing a growing concern among users on how to dispose of vapes properly. We are committed to minimising the impact our products have on the environment by offering our customers a **FREE** recycling service of any old, unwanted electrical items - we'll recycle **any** brand of vape bought from any other retailer as well as our own Totally Wicked branded products.

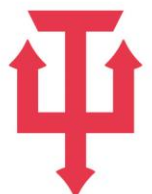
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How to identify electrical and electronic equipment (WEEE)?

To remind you that old electrical equipment can be recycled, it will be marked with the crossed-out wheelie bin symbol. This can be found either on the product itself or its packaging.

Any items marked with this symbol should NOT be disposed of in your normal household waste.

Please note: Atomizer heads/USB charging cables are always marked on the packaging only.



The Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment (WEEE) Regulations

The UK Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment (WEEE) 2013 Regulations require the UK to maximise the separate collection, reuse and recycling of WEEE. The UK WEEE Regulations applies to all Electrical and Electronic Equipment (EEE) placed on the UK market that are covered by the scope of these Regulations. Distributors are required to provide a system that allows all customers to recycle their old items free of charge. As a responsible retailer, Totally Wicked has met these requirements by offering our vape recycling scheme with WasteCare.

Battery Recycling

We also offer recycling of any kind of used portable (removable) batteries in Totally Wicked stores free of charge. For further information, please speak to a member of staff in-store. You may also contact your local authority for information on a recycling facility in your area that will accept your used batteries.
